WEEE Directive Statement

Williams Refrigeration and Falcon Foodservice Equipment, under the auspices of The AFE Group are fully aware of the many environmental responsibilities involved with equipment manufacture.

We are committed to ensuring that we continue to be market leaders not only in product and development, but also in being at the forefront of legislation compliance. This includes the new WEEE 2002/96/EC (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) and RoHS 2002/95/EC (Restriction of Harmful Substances) directives.

As you may be aware, the WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) Directive comes into force on 1st July 2007.

Williams and Falcon are members of REPIC Ltd., along with many of the leading electrical and electronic producers in the UK. Together with REPIC Ltd, we will ensure that affected appliances are either re-used or recycled at their end of life.

We have completed the following actions in order to comply with the directive:

1. Registered with a compliance scheme - REPIC Ltd
2. Identified EEE products using a crossed-out wheelie bin and black bar symbol in accordance with CENELEC EN 50419
3. Printed the Producer Registration number at the bottom of all invoices
4. Reproduced the Producer Registration number **WEE/DC0059TT/PRO**, in this letter.



Williams Refrigeration and Falcon Foodservice accept their responsibility to finance the cost of treatment of UK redundant WEEE, in accordance with specific WEEE recycling requirements. Note that certain Refrigeration products and modular equipment is decreed as hazardous waste because of the historic use of CFC and HCFC refrigerants in systems and insulation and must be safely disposed of separately from the WEEE regulations.

The AFE group does not charge for the administration and government duty applied to WEEE product, however there will be a surcharge for the onward safe transport of any waste product.

A full list of products applicable to WEEE regulations is available upon request.

Arranging a Collection

We will then advise on the procedure that applies to your particular unit.

The following information would be useful in the event of such an enquiry.

1. Manufacturer
2. Model
3. Serial number
4. Original Purchase Date

Any product requiring uplifted must be complete and not dismantled in the sense of WEEE. The product should not be contaminated with other waste and be in a clean state. Units must be disconnected by a qualified person and be in a secure and safe condition ready for uplift at the date and time specified.

Units must be available for uplift at kerbside with no vehicle access restrictions.

Note

Williams Refrigeration also offers facilities for the safe disposal of other Refrigeration products and modular equipment, classified as Hazardous waste. A charge applies for transportation and disposal of such products.
